Exit Surveys

The Exit Surveys (i.e., undergraduate, masters, and PhD) are designed to capture students’ perceptions of their experiences at Georgia Tech. The surveys are divided into two sections. Section one includes items that are common across all programs and section two program-specific items. The surveys are administered to graduating students during their final year (i.e., between degree petition and graduation).

The data is aggregated and reported on an annual basis. Following are links to each of the surveys to include access to the aggregate data.

If the education level of both parents is unknown or missing, then the student is defaulted to "Unknown."

**URM is an acronym for underrepresented minorities, specifically non-White and non-Asian students and students who are a combination of any race's and a non-minority group.

Data published in the visualizations are aggregated for the academic year (i.e., summer, fall, and spring)
